

Background

The furniture sector in EU is facing significant challenges, including:

- Increased reliance on a skilled workforce and efficient production techniques
- lack of sufficiently knowledgeable workers
- Need to better train existing and prospective workforce
- Maintain and upgrade employees qualifications and skills
- Continually transfer existing competencies and to create new ones

Objective

The idea of LILAC is to refine, implement and pilot a Web-based system that integrates competence management, e-learning and knowledge management to the benefit of workers employed in an organisation or preparing to enter the labour market, to improve life-long learning and knowledge sharing in the furniture industry

Expected results

1. Web-based system:
 - To manage job profiles and related competencies relevant to the furniture industry
 - To perform competence assessments
 - To share a knowledge base of information according to those competencies.
2. E-learning modules covering topics on Innovation, Ecodesign and International Marketing (in English, French, Italian, Spanish) that - make up learning pathways on topics linked to the job profiles.
